Dear Patient.

We are proposing a merger between the two practices run by Dr Kapil Kedia and Dr Nisha Kedia, which are Colney Medical Centre in London Colney, St. Albans and Coleridge House Medical Centre in Woodhall Farm, Hemel Hempstead from 1st April 2022.

Already both practices are working very closely together and sharing staff and resources. Dr Kapil Kedia's main base is in St. Albans and Dr Nisha Kedia's main base is in Hemel and these will continue unchanged, as will the supporting GPs working at their usual sites. Our Practice Nurse, Usha, will continue to work at both surgeries and our Administrator, Jade, will continue to oversee both surgeries.

Both practices are members of Alliance Primary Care Network and will continue to contribute to and benefit from this membership. We share our Clinical Pharmacist, Nafeesa, and First Contact Physiotherapist, Pallavi, and this will continue for both practices.

We are working with Herts Valley Clinical Commissioning Group (HVCCG) to upgrade the phone system at both surgeries to allow call queueing and other more patient friendly options. The new system will make it much easier for additional staff capacity to be deployed at busy periods, which will benefit patients. Both practices use EMIS Web clinical system and it is proposed to merge these systems so that all clinics can be seen on a single screen.

Overall, we are looking to harness the advantages of a larger outfit but retain the benefits of our smaller, friendly practices where we know the patients and our patients know us.
